

Current Slash Disposal Sites : Southwest Colorado

The following sites are currently approved for the disposal of slash generated from thinning and defensible space efforts.

Dolores County

- **The Town of Dove Creek** has a slash disposal site for town residents at the located at the water tank on the north side of town. The site is free of charge but intended for town residents only. Acceptable waste includes tree limbs and grass clippings. No household trash, lumber or construction refuse is accepted.
- **The Dolores County Transfer Station** is accepting slash and other yard waste.

Disposal costs are as follows;

○ Farm Truck w/ 4ft. side rails	\$50	\$100
○ Over 4'	\$6/ft.	\$12/ft.

The Transfer Station is located at 13090 County Road M, Dove Creek. Operating hours are Friday – Monday from 9:00 am. – 5:00 pm.

Montezuma County

- **The Montezuma County Landfill** is accepting slash and other yard waste in conjunction with the City of Cortez. Tree limbs are piled separate from leaves grass clippings and garden waste.

The following CLEAN items are accepted.

- **Grass Clippings (un-bagged)**
- **Leaves (un-bagged)**
- **Small limbs and branches**
- **Garden waste (vegetation only)**

Clean means without contamination! **No** paper, plastic bags, household trash, wire, bricks, concrete, blocks, timbers, large trees, treated wood, landscaping material, or similar items. Any loads found with contamination may be subject to a minimum fine of \$50 plus 1.5 times the cost of cleanup.

Disposal costs are as follows:

- \$22.00 / Ton for yard waste.
- \$7.00 min. load fee

The Landfill is located at 26100 County Road F. Operating hours are from 8:00 am. to 4:00 pm. Monday – Saturday.

La Plata County

- **The Bayfield Transfer Station** is currently accepting “brown waste” free of charge from Memorial Day to Labor Day. “Brown waste” is composed of tree branches including evergreens, “Green waste” such as lawn clipping is not accepted. Tree limbs are chipped into mulch and are available to the public free of charge.

The Transfer station is located on County Road 223 and is open four days per week.

Archuleta County

- **The Arboles Transfer Station** is accepting slash and other yard waste.
- Cost is \$6.00/ cubic yard for Archuleta County Residents.

The Arboles Transfer Station is located on County Road 973, and operating hours are from 10:00 am. – 5:00 pm. Tuesday – Saturday. Closed Sunday and Monday.

- **The Pagosa Transfer Station** is accepting slash and other yard waste.

Disposal costs are as follows;

- \$6.00 / Cubic yard for residents

The Pagosa Transfer Station is located on County Road 500 (Trujillo Road), operating hours are from 11:00 am – 5:00 pm Tuesday – Sunday. Closed Monday

- **The Pagosa Landfill** is accepting slash and other yard waste.

Disposal costs are as follows;

- \$6.00/ Cubic yard for residents

The Pagosa Landfill is located on County Road 500 (Trujillo Road) operating hours are from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm Monday – Friday, and 10:00 am to 2:00 pm Saturday. Closed Sunday.
